

It is not its original block, it was replaced when first restored by Lenn Bull.





#### **KNOWN HISTORY**

The car was first registered on 20th June 1935.

It was purchased by my Godfather Lionel Phillips (known as Phil) in November 1982 and restored by Leonard Bull of Monza Classic Cars over an 18 month period. The car was completed and delivered to Phil on 18<sup>th</sup> April 1984 and was kept and run until his death in 2003.

Phil drove the car throughout Great Britain as well as Europe and entered into rallys and hill climbs.

After a career in the Ghurkas, Phil went on to be a Queens Messenger hence the "to do" notes from exotic places regarding the car.

My mother Winefred Maddison inherited the car after Phil passed away and it continued to be driven by my husband Kevin Grahame. It was entered into the MG clubs Brooklands to Brighton rally where it started as the 4<sup>th</sup> oldest entry. She moved out of the area in 2007 and no longer had a garage to keep the car in so she passed this on to my husband on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2007. Kevin Grahame is still the registered owner and the car continues to be driven and enjoyed. A full service has recently been carried out at Surrey Sports & Classics in Ripley, Guildford.

#### ASSUMED HISTORY

We have carried out some investigation as to the history of the car prior to Phil's ownership but cannot confirm the complete accuracy as this has come from various parties.

We believe that the car was supplied ex factory to Cockshoot & Co. Ltd in Manchester where it was used as a demonstrator and the first owner is believed to have been Hon. H Westenra.
